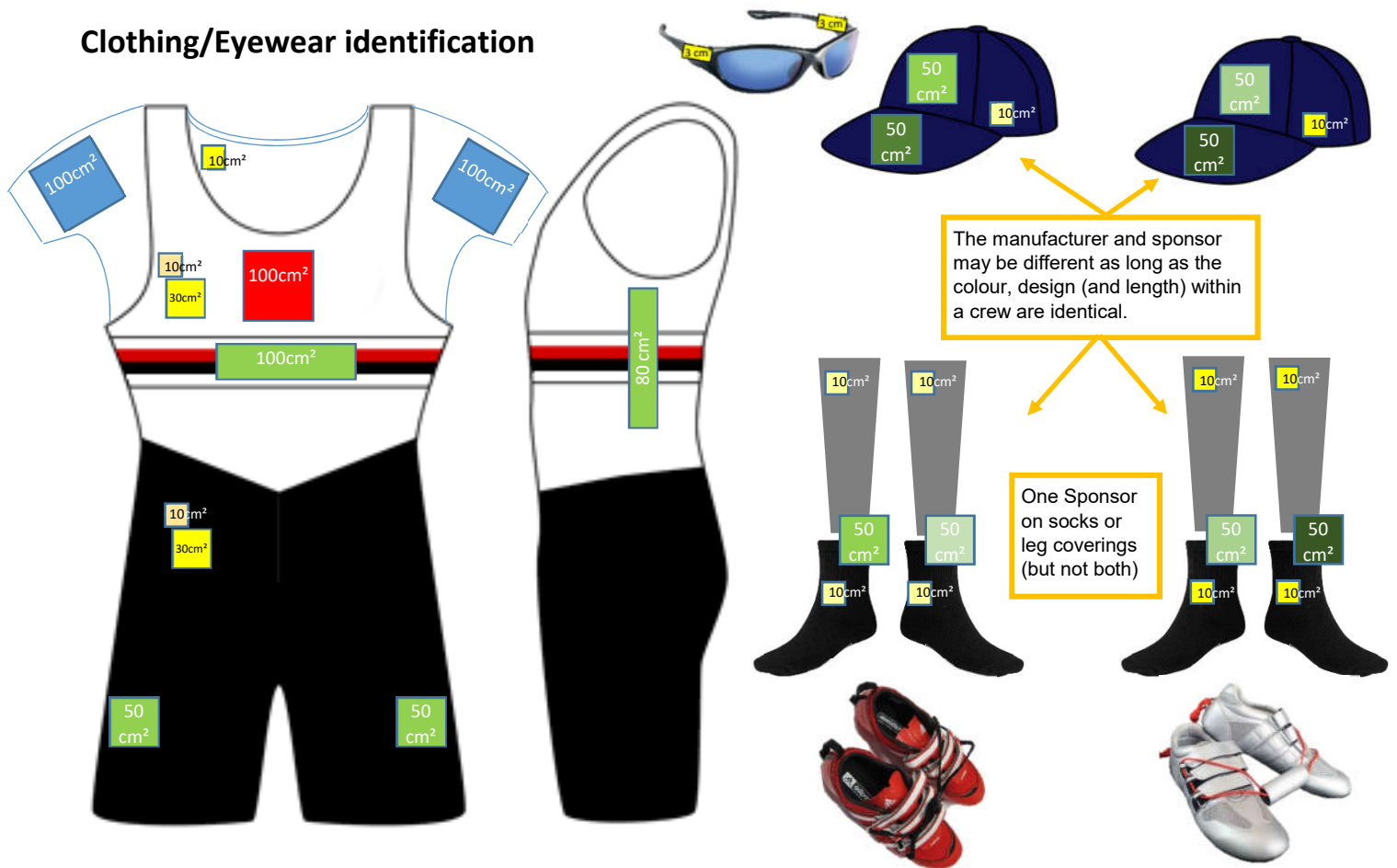

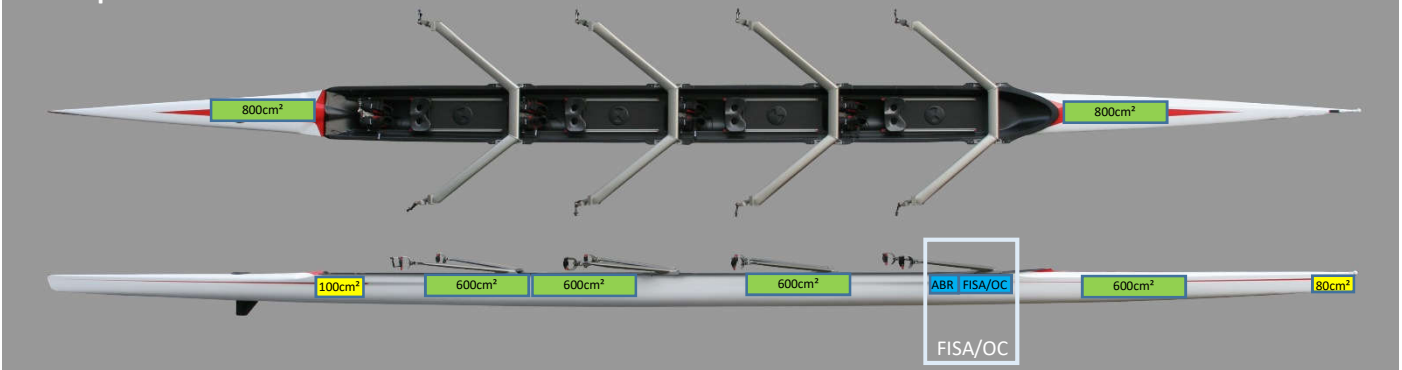

Shoes Quick Release	Rowers may wear shoes of a different colour and manufacturer in the boat. Shoes worn at FISA Events, including the quick-release strap, may carry the Identification of the Manufacturer as generally used on products sold through the retail trade during the period of six months or more prior to the relevant event.				
Eyewear	Once per arm, max 3 cm ² each; OR once on one arm, max 6 cm ²				

- Identifications on all clothing items must be identical within a crew except as specifically provided.
- + National ID: no limit in space, if on uniform it must be part of official design approved by FISA (Rule 51), incl. national colours, country name or acronym, national flag

Boat identification

- Identifications on all equipment items and fittings in the boat must be identical within a boat/crew
- With the exception of the production Plaque, no other Identification of the manufacturer is allowed on racing boats.

Sponsor Identifications and Boat Name on the side of the boat

- Identifications permitted on the side of the boat are the name of the boat and/or the Identification of the sponsor(s)
- The name of the boat shall be considered as a sponsor
- Each sponsor Identification on the side of the boat shall be positioned apart from the FISA Identification.
- On each side of the boat the sponsor Identifications may be combined into one or more larger Identifications
- The sponsor Identifications may be different.

Oars identification

Outboard	No identifications are allowed on the outboard section		
Inboard	Manufacturer	60 cm ²	
Inboard	Advertising Space	72 cm ²	100 cm ²
Inboard	+ discrete marking to identify owner, boat and/or position		

- The colours and design of the blades of all oars and sculls shall be identical on both sides.
- Identifications on all oars/sculls must be identical within a boat/crew
- The only other markings allowed on sculling or sweep oars are discreet marks to identify the owner, the particular boat and/or the position in which it is used.
