REGULATIONS AIM AND TASK OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

AIM – to promote and popularize the rowing sport in the Baltic States, particularly in Jūrmala city

TASKS:

- 1. To define the best rowers in the Baltic States in the three age groups juniors, seniors and masters
- **2.** The championship is regarded as the last checkup before the Europian Ch-ps U-23 and good chance to complete the Junior team for the next year.

PARTICIPANTS

Estonian, Latvian and Lithuanian teams take part at the Championship in the three age groups:

- Juniors (born in 2001 and younger)
- Seniors (born in 2000 and older)
- Masters (from the age of 27)

AWARDS

The first three places in the 2000 m final and the winner in the 500 m final get medals. The team – winner will be presented with a Cup.

A team - winner is determined according to the biggest sum of points in individual ranking of the first three places in junior and senior events. Team winner is determined as follows:

1st place 5 points 2nd place 3 points 3rd place 1 point

The winners in the Master group are determined by use of the age coefficient.

The Opening ceremony and the Awarding of the first day medalists will take place at rowing centre MSG TSV Jūrmala, Majori, Jaunā Street 66.

On the Championship's second day Awarding ceremony will be held directly at the finish zone after each race.

Team - winner awarding will take place at the finish zone 15 minutes after the last race.
