Practice Starts

Practice starts will take place on Friday, 8 October from 10:00 to 11:30 and will be carried out in lanes 4, 5, 6 and 7. Crews shall follow the published Traffic Rules for Practice Starts, in addition to any instructions of the marshals and the jury in the start area. If crews would like to repeat their practice starts, they must turn at the 400-meter mark, go into lanes 0 to 2 and row towards the start. Crews wishing to continue their training after the practice starts shall pass the 500-meter mark and follow the usual traffic rules for training.

Control Commission

The Control commission is located next to the outgoing pontoons (Venue Map No. 13) and will be in operation during all times the course is officially open.

Crew Changes & Registration

Crew changes (including withdrawals) before Wednesday 6 October must be submitted via the official crew change form, which should be sent electronically by the team managers to registration@worldrowing.com. From Thursday 7 October onwards, the Crew Change forms should be submitted in hard copy to the European Rowing office at the venue. In case of a medical substitution or withdrawal, Team Managers must contact the OC doctor first by phone and then submit the crew change form at the venue.

All Team Managers are requested to check and confirm their entries by 14:00 on Friday 8 October (3 hours before the draw).

Bow Numbers

The bow numbers will be distributed to the crews on the outgoing pontoon and collected at the incoming pontoon.

Athletes Weighing

The Athletes Weighing is in the Team Information building (Venue Map No. 12). Weighing for coxes is possible 2 hours before until 1 hour before the respective race.







Average Temperature

Average Temperature and Humidity



Boat Storage

The Organising Committee will provide boat racks in the boat storage area and in selected boat hangars. The racks will be labelled according to boat category (1x, 2x/2-, 4x/4-, 4+, 8+), but will not be assigned to a specific crew. The Organising Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or losses. Teams are responsible for ensuring that boats are securely tied down at all times.

Launch Pontoons

Teams must use the outgoing and incoming pontoons as shown on the traffic rules maps (see above). Shoes and items of clothing should not be left on the pontoons during training or racing sessions. Please do not leave plastic bottles or rubbish on the pontoons after training or racing.

Team Tents

The area available for team tents is located behind the boat hangars and the boat trailer space (Venue Map No. 2). Team tents may only be set-up in the designated area.

Changing Rooms, Showers and Toilets

There are changing rooms, showers and toilets located in two buildings in the boat park (Venue Map No. 6). The facilities will be cleaned frequently.

Coaches Viewing

During training, coaches can follow on bikes from the path along the course on both sides of the course. During racing, coaches can follow the racing on the side opposite of the Finish Tower only. Teams will have free access to the terrace below the nation flags on the side opposite the Finish Tower.

Baggage Drop

The baggage drop is in boat hangar 1 (Venue Map No.4) and will be open during all venue opening hours open. The OC does not take responsibility for items lost at the venue.

Lost and Found

Lost and Found is located at the Team Information (Venue Map No. 12).

Garbage Collection

Bins have been placed on the venue and in the boathouse area for garbage collection. All attendees are encouraged to use the recycling bins throughout the venue. For larger items, please use the containers close to the team tent area, the boat services park, or the team catering.

Transportation and Parking Services for Teams

Transportation to and from the airport will be provided to the hotels or the venue for those teams that have booked the airport transfer service. Teams should confirm in advance if they wish to go from the airport directly to the venue, and whether they will bring oars.

A shuttle service between the venue and the official event hotels will be offered to all teams who booked the accommodation via the Organising Committee. The operating times will be published at the Team Information and on the event website www.erjch2021.com.

Team cars and boat trailers can be parked at the trailer and team parking area (Venue Map No. 3).

Food Facilities and Services

Lunch at the Venue

Lunch will be served at the venue daily from 11:00 – 15:00. For teams who have booked accommodation via the Organising Committee, lunch is included in the full board rate. All other teams need to book lunch service in advance via https://max.m-start.de.

Mealtimes at the Hotels

Medical Facilities and Services

Medical Centre

The Medical Centre is in main regatta building (Venue Map No. 20) and is open during the venue opening hours.

Doping Control

The Doping control (Venue Map No. 10) is in the Team Information building (Venue Map No. 12). For all information on the Doping control procedures, please refer to the World Rowing Rule Book. The latest WADA list of prohibited substances can be found on www.wada-ama.org.

First Aid Service, Ambulance and Local Hospital

An ambulance is located next to the Medical Centre during the venue opening hours. During racing, a medical car will be located near the incoming pontoons.

The closest hospital is the Helios Amper-Klinikum Dachau, Krankenhausstr. 15, 85221 Dachau, phone +49-(0)8131-76-0, located 10 minutes from the venue.

Important Note

The expenses for any medical treatments during your stay in Germany are the responsibility of the patient. All Member Federations are responsible for adequately insuring their team members according to Rule 15 of the World Rowing Rules of Racing.

Covid-related rules and practices

Covid Pre-Health screening

All participants (athletes, officials, support staff) attending the event will need to fill in a pre-event health questionnaire online. Please register in our online system https://www.m-start.de as a team manager (if you don't have a login yet from previous regattas in Munich). We will assign your athletes in the system automatically and you can fill in the questionnaires online or send them to your participants separately via email.

Covid Test Centre Opening Hours

Daily rapid (antigen) testing will be offered on site in boat hangar 7 (shuttle stop side, Venue Map No. 5). The opening hours are:

Thursday, 7 October 15:30 – 17:30 Friday, 8 October 15:30 – 17:30

Saturday, 9 October 11:00 – 13:00 (PCR tests only)

16:00 - 18:00 (antigen tests only)

Sunday, 10 October 13:00 – 16:00

Tests must be booked online in advance via https://max.m-start.de and paid in advance.

Spectators

The use of the existing grandstand at the venue is currently not permitted. The Organising Committee has found a solution to provide family and friends of the athlete's access to a viewing area in front of the old grandstand facing the medal ceremony.

Tickets can be purchased online at a price of 10 € per day. Please check our website at www.regatta.de for up-to-date information on the ticketing process.

Access to the area will be via the Munich Beach Resort. Parking for spectators will be 5 €/day.

Food services will be available at the Munich Beach Resort.

Please note: Germany's so called "3G-rule" (geimpft, genesen, getestet – vaccinated, recovered, tested) applies for any ticket purchase and will be checked upon entry.

As per the COVID Response Plan, Teams are required NOT to enter the spectator area, and should limit contact with spectators (keeping team and crew bubbles where possible). Team viewing is possible on the terrace under the nations flags on the side of the course opposite the finish tower.
