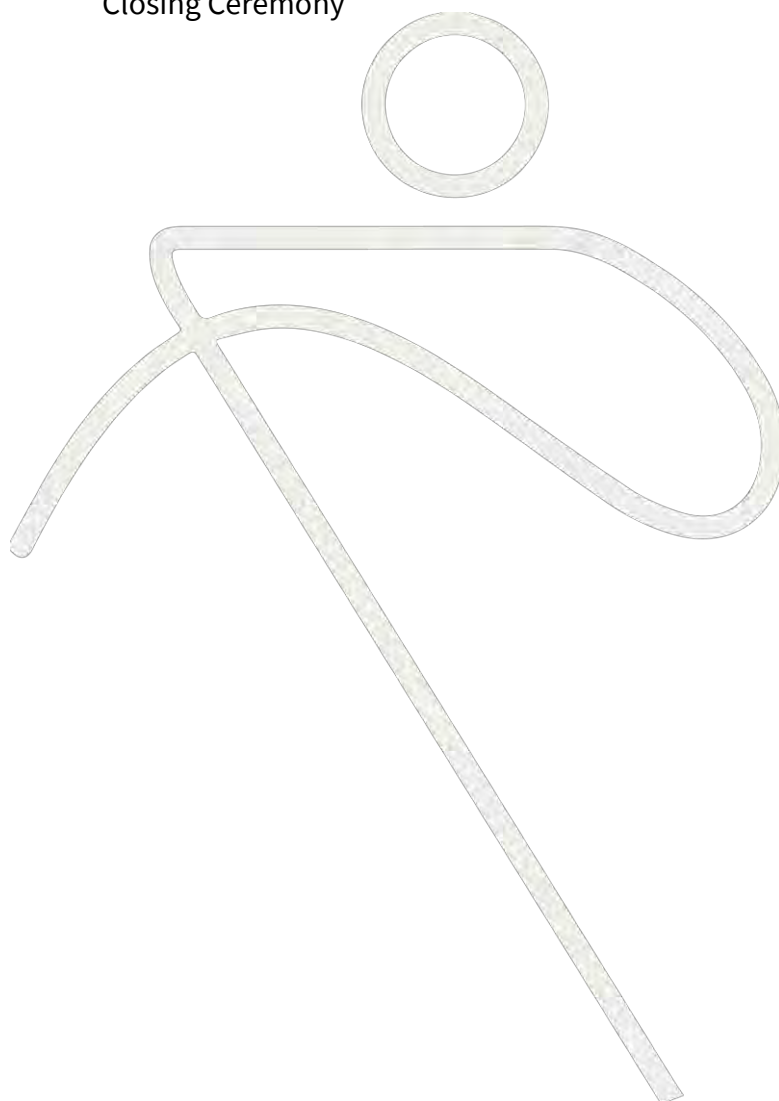

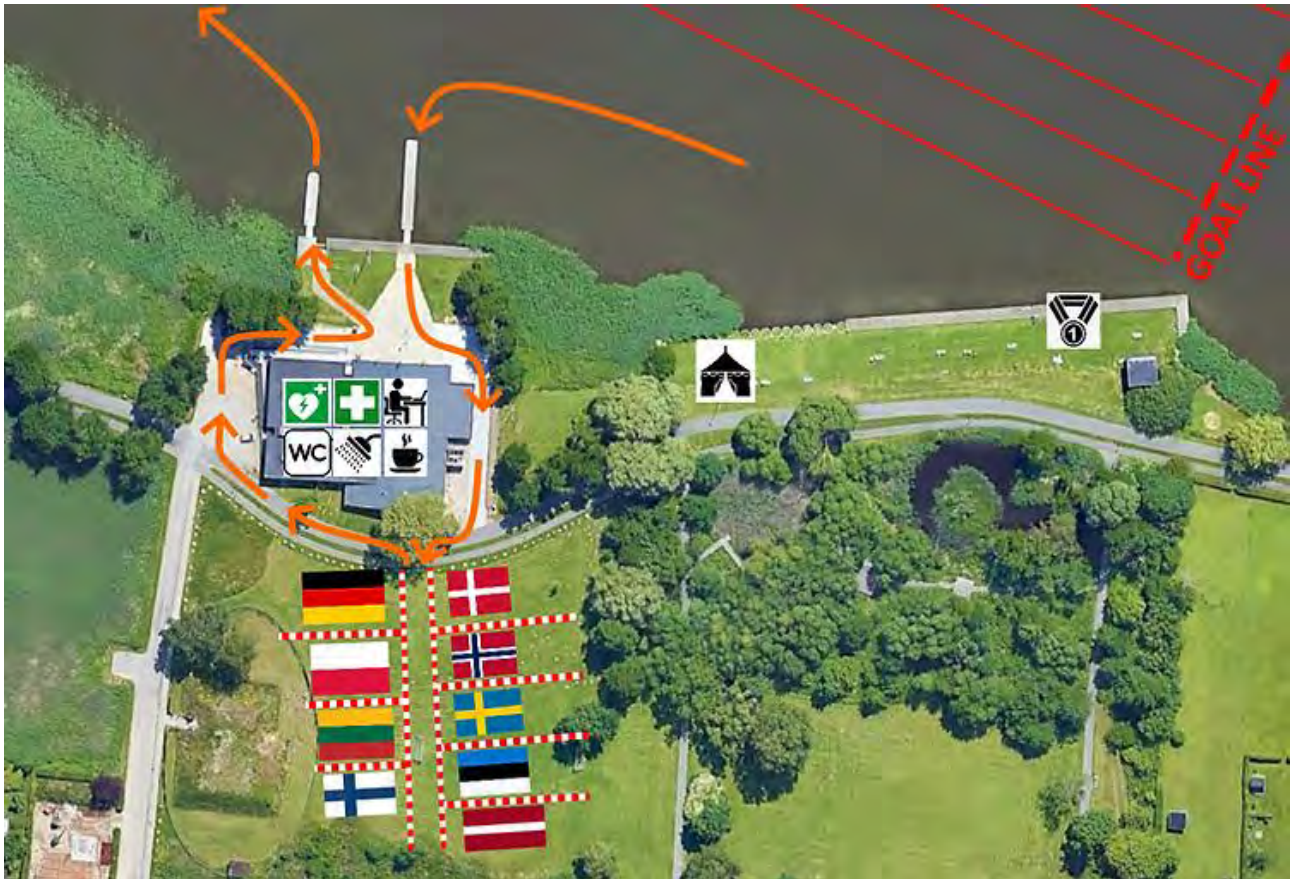
## Venue

The rowing stadium is located at Lake Brabrand at Vandværksvej 14, 8220 Brabrand, Denmark.



There will be a small café located at the venue. The café can only accept Danish kroner and euro.

Accreditation center, toilet facilities and bath can be found at venue, as well as a tent for shelter.

## Parking for busses at venue

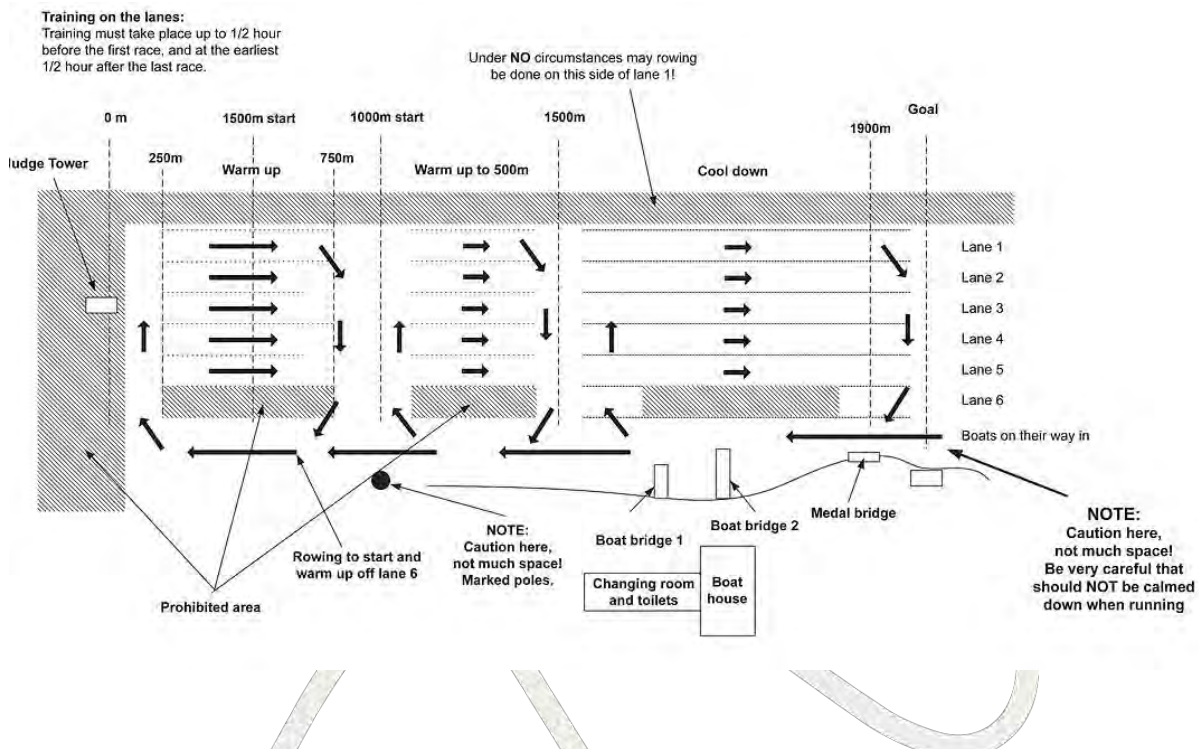
From **Thursday to Friday** busses can park at Brabrand Hallen, Engdalsvej 84, 8220 Brabrand.



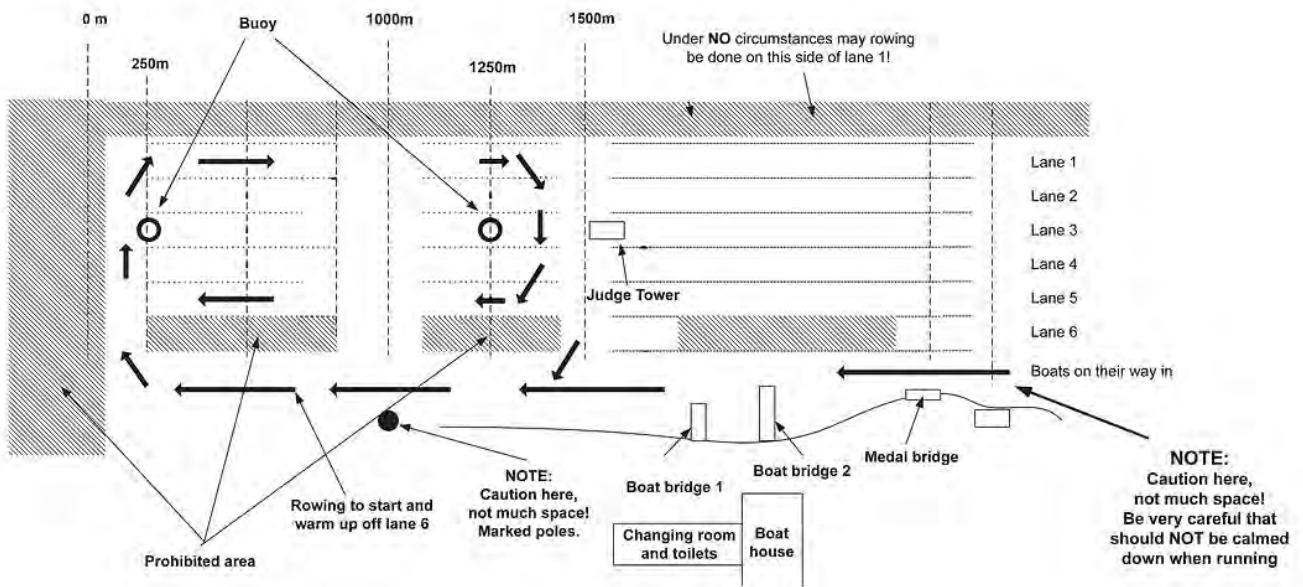

**Training on the lanes:**  
Training must take place up to 1/2 hour before the first race, and at the earliest 1/2 hour after the last race.





## **Accommodation at Book1**

All teams will be accommodated at Book1 in the center of Aarhus.  
The address is Møllegade 3A, 8000 Aarhus.



The route from Book1 to Brabrand Rowing Stadium is 6,7km and takes approximately 15-20 minutes. When you arrive to Brabrand Rowing Stadium via Silkeborgvej, please please follow the BLUE line to Brabrand Rowing Stadium. The **RED line** shows a road that is closed.

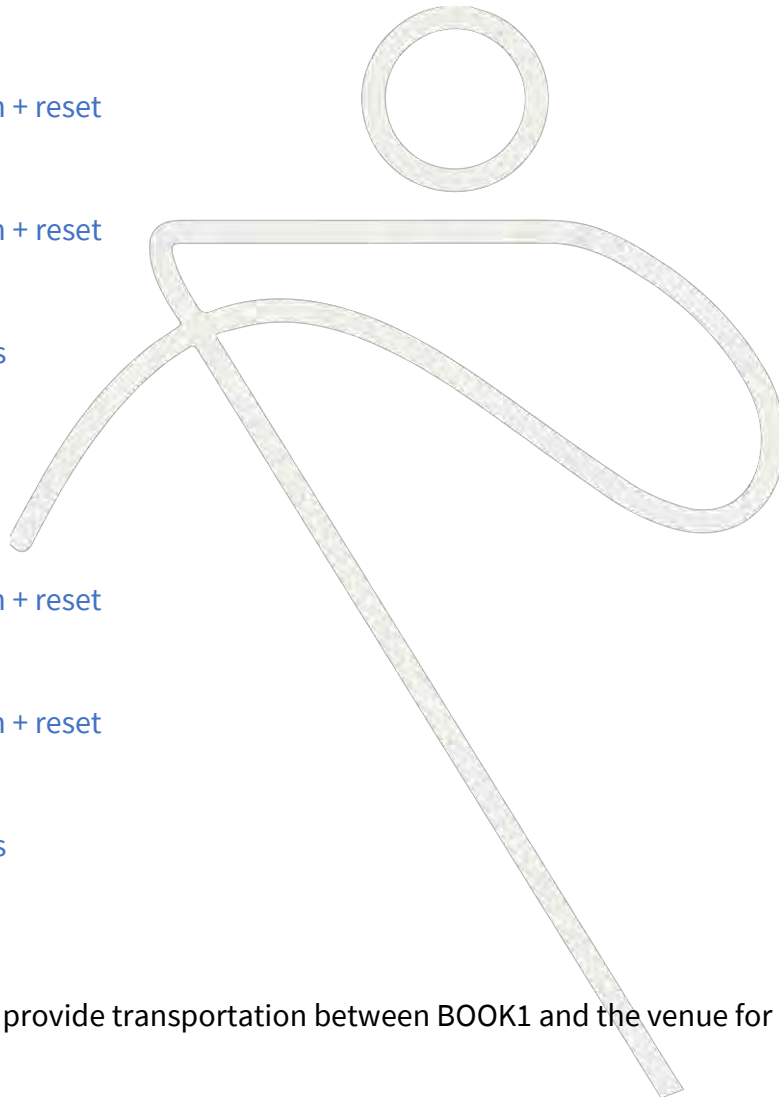

## **Transport**

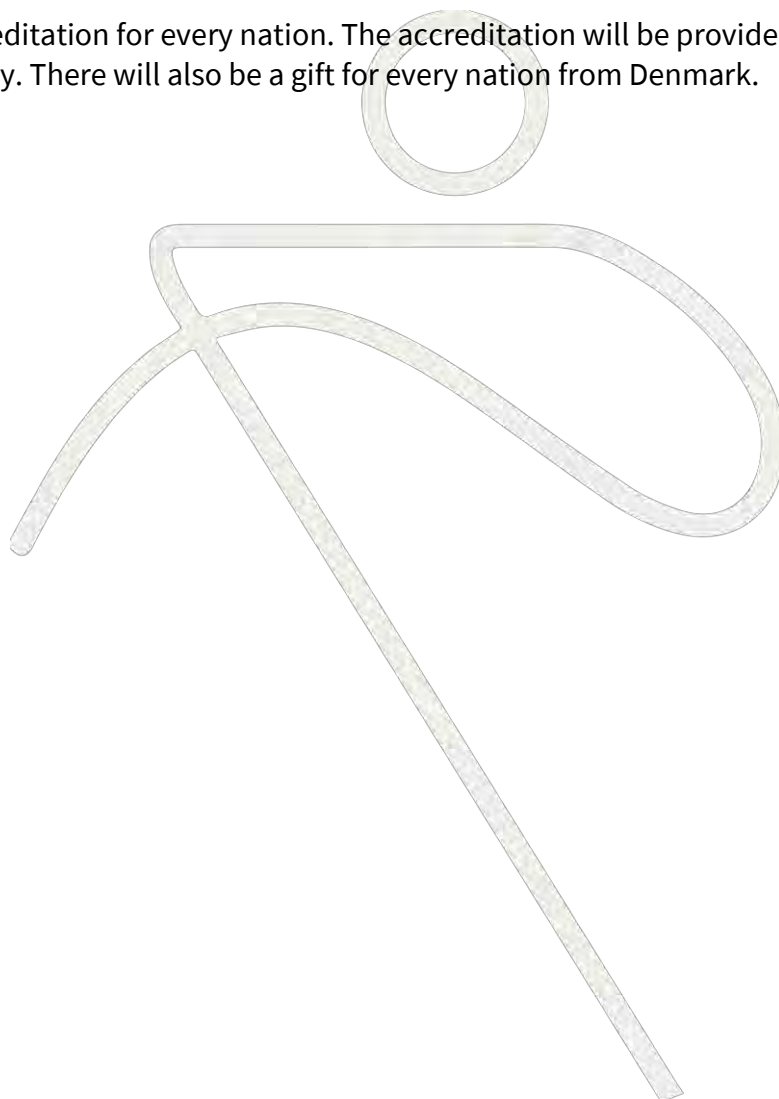
Every nation must provide transportation between BOOK1 and the venue for themselves.
