The inhabitants of Brive, affectionately know as the "Gaillards", are true ambassadors of the destination and offer visitors a warm welcome that is unique to them. The strong values of the southwest such as cohesion, solidarity and team spirit are found everywhere!



#### And why "Gaillarde" ?

Many people wonder where the nickname "Gaillarde" comes from. In the 12th and 19th centuries, Brive was fortified ramparts and began to forge its strong character an ambitious city and to establish its independence, officially recognized from 1361. But it is said that this nickname actually dates back to the 20th century: Brive, marked by the Second World War, was the first French town to free itself from the Nazi grip, without any help from the Allied forces.

With its ramparts, Brive could have lost its epithet, but the city has remained faithful to its values and is keen to keep this nickname which is its greatest pride!

#### • Brive 100% Gourmet:

If we had to retain one value for our territory, it would most certainly be gourmandise! Indeed, the territory abounds in exceptional products that give daily pleasure to the inhabitants and delight the taste buds of our visitors. Walnuts, truffes, foie gras, "moutarde de violette" (purple mustard) or cheeses such as "fôte des bergères", there is something for everyone!

Epicureans at heart and above all when it comes to the plate, our Gaillard chefs handle them superbly and suggest traditional, bistro or gourmet recipes.

#### • Brive 100% Discovery

The Brive region is full of natural and historic sites to discover during your future stay with us; we have made a selection of the must-sees:

#### -> The Most Beautiful Villages of France:

Situated on a hillock, the village of Turenne has kept many traces of its history: the "César and Trésor" towers, the remains of the castle dominating the village, the ancient mansions from the 15th to the 17th centuries. Turenne is a medieval jewel and is one of the most important historical sites in the Brive region. The medieval town of Saint-Robert is home to a 12th century church, a 16th century chapel, charming little streets and a miraculous fountain that is the talk of the town: legend has it that its water cured children who were sick at birth.



#### ->The Pans of Travassac:

"Les Pans de Travassac" slope are one of the last active slate quarries in France. This unique natural open-air site with vertically rasing slate pans is open to the public for an impressive visit: the slate pits of the site are up to 140 meters deep. This slate, reputed to be one of the strongest in the world, can be found sites such as the roofs of the Mont-Saint-Michel abbey: a 14-year project completed in March 2015.

#### ->The Gardens of Colette:

The gardens of Colette, entirely created by the landscape architect Anouk Debarre, retraces the life of the writer Colette, through the plants, flowers, smells and atmospheres of the different places where she lived. Numerous family activities are offered throughout the year in the garden and a 5000m2 labyrinth in the shape of a butterfly awaits the children, who will be able to discover, in a playful way, the history of Colette through riddles and games.

#### • Brive 100% sports

Between remarkable landscapes, typical villages and preserved natural areas, Brive is the ideal setting for the practice of leisure or competitive sports activities. The climate is temperate, benefiting from the influence of the nearby Aquitaine region. With an average of 2000 hours of sunshine per year, the Brive basin is ideal for all kinds of sports. We are fortunate to have a number of practice spots in the area, including 2 major ones:

#### —> the Lac du Causse :

With 200 hectares developed (100 hectares of water, 100 hectares of natural areas), the Lac du Causse site is a showcase for our region. This high level training and competition site regularly welcomes French and foreign teams for physical preparation courses, national, European or even world championships in various disciplines (rowing, triathlon, swimming ...).



### —>The "Saillant":

The "Saillant" marks the boundary between the fast flowing waters of the middle Vézère and the calm waters that lead it to its confluence with the Dordogne. Alternating granite and gneiss soils forms a deep valley plateau that particularly delights mountain bikers. A few kilometers from the Lac du Causse, it is a reference training site for the FFCK (French canoe kayak federation). The "via ferra-ta"/ climbing trail of the La Roche site also allows novice climbers to gain height over the extraordinary landscapes of the Vézère gorges.

These two activity spots form "Causse Saillant" open-air centre and have label such as: nature sport centre, FFCTT mountain bike base or even "Terre de Jeux" for the Olympic games 2024.

Multiple, varied and quirky, the destination is a little haven of peace where it is good to spend time with friends or family. From heritage, entertainment to major events such as the Brive Festival, the Festival of good breeding, fine dining, or the famous Book Fair, there is something for everyone and every budget. An accessible destination, you will be welcomed here as if you were friends and above all you will leave feeling refreshed!

## LAC DU CAUSSE:

The Lac du Causse, located in a green environment, in the valley of the Couze, was created about 40 years ago.

This lake is located on the border of 3 communes, those of Chasteaux, Lissac sur Couze and Saint Cernin de Larche.

During the last years, the lake of the Causse has hosted many national and international sports events.

Since a few years the Lake of Causse welcomes every year the Regional Rowing Championships.

It is a great place for tourism and leisure for locals and visitors alike. You can enjoy a wide range of water sports such as canoeing, paddling, swimming, ... In addition, the surroundings of the lake, the hilly landscapes and the multitude of paths are an ideal playground for hikers, mountain bikers and trail runners.
