AWARDS

The first three places in the 2000 m final and the winner in the 500 m final get medals. The team winner will be presented with a Cup.

National team ranking will be determined by points. Points will be awarded to crews based on the results of the finals. The points will be awarded as follows:

1st place - 5 points

2nd place - 3 points

3nd place - 1 point

The winner in Master group are determined by use of the age coefficient.

The Opening ceremony and the Awarding of the first day medalists will take place in rowing center at 19.30.

On the Championship's second day Awarding ceremony will be held directly at the in-coming boat pontoon after each race.

Team-winner awarding will take place at the boat house 20 minutes after the last race.
