Info centre

# Accreditation

Accreditation centre is located on the first floor of the Grandstand (Otok Univerzijade - Island of Universiade). Please see map.

All Team managers have been provided with a link and password to upload their accreditation information onto the OC portal.

Please note: the racing programme will be confirmed after the entries are final and the draw.

### Team Managers Meeting and the Draw

The Team Managers Meeting and the Draw will take place on Thursday, 4th May in Team managers meeting room on the ground floor at the back side of Grandstands at 15:00.

### **Training and Competition**

#### Traffic Rules – Training

The traffic rules for training will apply at all times when the Course is open for training. Be aware that on racing days all crews must leave the course 15 minutes before the first race start (see map).

#### Traffic Rules – Racing

The traffic rules for racing will apply from 15 minutes before the start of the first race, until 15 minutes after the finish of the last race (see map).

### **Control Commission**

Located next to the "outgoing" pontoons (see map). The Control Commission will be in operation during all the times the course is officially open.

### **Crew Changes**

Upon arrival, Team Managers are requested to check their crew entries at the Registration and Accreditation centre. In case of any changes in the crew's composition, seating order or spelling of the names, they must complete the Crew Change Form and submit to Monika Briedyte at the World Rowing registration desk at the regatta venue. For medical substitutions and withdrawals after the draw, please see the World Rowing Doctor at the World Rowing office followed by submission of the crew change form.

### **Crew** photos

Team Managers will be notified of the athletes that have not yet had their photographs taken for the World Rowing athletes database. These athletes should report to the accreditation centre and have their photographs taken and passports scanned prior to issuing accreditation?

### **Bow Numbers**

The bow numbers will be distributed to the crews on the outgoing pontoon and collected at the incoming pontoon by OC volunteers



### **Country Code Stickers**

For safety reasons crews will be required to have their country code stickers on the boats before being allowed onto the water, both for training and racing. OC volunteers or NTOs will assist the crews to fix the stickers on the boats. Please plan for sufficient time for the fixing of the stickers before the first training session.

### **Blades Identification**

As described in the WR Rules, from the time that the venue is officially open for training, National Federations are required to ensure that all blades be painted in NF colours - before going on the water. NTO's from the OC will enforce this guideline.

### **GPS Devices**

All boats must be fitted with a 'base plate' to hold the GPS timing devices. These plates will be fixed to the boats by a team of OC volunteers and by Swiss Timing technicians from Wednesday, 3rd May in the Boat Weighing area (see map). Please ensure they are in place before the first day of racing.

# Advertising

Please check the WR Rules of Racing and related Bye-Laws to ensure that all racing equipment complies with the advertising rules.

### **Boat weighing**

The boat weighting is located in the outside boathouse structure (see map). Test scales will be available on Wednesday (3rd May) and Thursday (4th May) and will be open at all times that the venue is open.

# **Athletes Weighing**

Athletes (including coxswains) weighing will take place in the Boathouse (see map ) and according to the WR rules. A test scale is available during the official opening hours of the Venue. Athletes needs to present their accreditation at the official weigh-in.

### Weather updates

During the regatta, an on-site meteorologist will monitor weather conditions and provide weather forecasts. These forecasts will be made available via publication boards that are found at the Info Centre and the Control Commission hut (see map).

# TEAM FACILITIES AND SERVICES



### **Boat Storage**

The Organising Committee will provide boat racks in the boat storage area. The racks will be labelled according to boat category (1x, 2x/2-, 4x/4-, 4+, 8+), and will be assigned to specific crews. The Organizing Committee will not be held responsible for any damage or losses. Teams are responsible for ensuring that boats are securely tied down at all times.

### **Boat repair**

Boat builders and boat repair workshops will be located near to the Info Centre.

### Launch Pontoons

Teams must use the 'out-going' and 'in-coming' pontoons as shown on the traffic circulation maps (see maps). No plastic bottles are to be left on the pontoons after training or racing. Coaches are required to remove athlete's shoes away from the outgoing and incoming pontoons – and onto the grassed areas for safety reasons.

### **Boat washing**

The boat washing area is in front of the boathouse. No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used for boat washing.

### **Team Tents**

Due to limited space at the Venue, the area available for team tents is restricted. Team tents may only be set-up in the designated area as indicated on the map. Any request from the Organising Committee to relocate team tents must be respected. All teams please ensure that a minimum of 2 meters space between tents is maintained.

### Warming-up area

Warming-up area is provided on the Island of Universiade (Otok Univerzijade) and Island Tresnjevka (Otok Trešnjevka) near boathouse area. Ergometers and bikes are located in the outside boathouse structures (see map). Please clean and disinfect ergometers and bikes before and after use.

### **Changing Rooms, Showers and Toilets**

There are changing rooms, showers and toilets located at various points in the boat park (see map). These facilities will be cleaned regularly.

### Massage

Massage area is located in Ground floor of Boat house (see map). The OC does not provide physiotherapist or massage services. Please clean and disinfect massage area before and after use.

# **Coaches Viewing**

Coaches can observe training on bikes from the TV Road along the lake on the opposite side of the Finish Tower only. Biking would be allowed to follow races on Friday 5th May. Biking may be allowed on Saturday/ Sunday but not confirmed as TV and commentary cars would be using the road. Further details will be given at the Team managers meeting on Thursday 4th May.

During racing, teams will have free access to the grandstands.

# **Bag Drop**

The bag drop facility is located in the Boathouse (see map). The bag drop will be open at the times that the Venue is open. The OC is responsible only for things left in Bag Drop.

### **Lost and Found**

The lost and found facility is located at the OC Secretariat (see map).

### **Cleanliness on the Site**

A number of rubbish bins have been placed on the site and in the boathouse area for the collection of trash. All participants are encouraged to use the recycling bins throughout the Venue.

# Cycling

Cycling is permitted on lower road by the lake ONLY during training. During races, cycling on lower road (near course) is PROHIBITED

To participants who disobey this instructions, their accreditation can be revoked and access to the Venue can be banned for them during the Event takes place.

Cycling in Athletes and boats area is prohibited! In these areas, please push your bike by your side.



# **Medical Centre**

The Medical Centre is located in the Boathouse area (see map). The Centre will be open at all times that the Venue is open.

# **Doping Control**

Doping Control Centre is located on the First floor of Boathouse (see map). For all information on the Doping Control procedures, please refer to the WR Rule Book. The latest WADA list of prohibited substances can be found on www.wada-ama.org

# First Aid Service, Ambulance and Local Hospital

An ambulance will be located next to the Medical Centre at all times that the Venue is open. During racing an additional ambulance will be located near the Victory Ceremony area.

The official hospital for all 2023 World Rowing Cup I participants is the Clinical Hospital Centre Zagreb (KBC Zagreb), Kišpatićeva ulica 12, 10 000 Zagreb, located 20 minutes from the Regatta Venue.

### Transport to and from the Airport

Transport will be provided from the airport to the hotels or Venue for those teams who provide arrival/ departure details at least 24 hours in advance. Teams should inform Transport Office of any oversized baggage (eg. oars).

There will be volunteers at the airport, at arrivals gate, holding the sign I World cup Zagreb, Croatia. Volunteers will escort teams to the official shuttles.

### Hotel Bus Shuttle - Teams

Official shuttle transport will operate from 03.05.2023. till 07.05.2023.. On Wednesday from 7:30 till 19:00. From Thursday till Saturday from 6:30 till 19:00 On Sunday from 6:30 till 15:00 Transport before/after this days will be available upon request. ### **Team Parking Arrangements**

There is a limited parking at the Venue. Team Managers will receive a parking pass at the OC Accreditation Centre (see map) for a team vehicle, that is bringing the equipment, to enter the park area at Jarun lake. Vehicles with equipment are permitted to drive to boathouse area to unload equipment and then return to team vehicle parking.

The parking for Team with parking pass (provided at Accreditation) is located near Boat house area (see map).

### **Boat Trailers**

Trailers are allowed to go to boathouse area to unload boats and equipment. Trailers needs to be parked at designated space for trailers near the fence in Boat house area. The Venue Manager will coordinate the positioning of the trailers. All boats must be removed from the boathouse area by 20:00 hrs on Sunday, 7th May.

### Team Cars / Buses

Team buses, cars and technical vehicles without an access pass will not be allowed to enter the Venue.
