#### VENUE

#### Trakai, Lithuania

The name of Trakai was first mentioned in Teutonic Knights chronicles in 1337. This year is considered to be the official date of town's foundation. Trakai - historical capital of ancient Lithuania fascinates with its wooden architecture, medieval castle, and magnificent scenery and at the same time – a modern face of the town. Galve Lake, where Amber Oars regatta will be held, at its deepest point is 46.75 metres (its area is 361 ha). The pride of Trakai is the Island Castle, the only castle in Eastern Europe built on an island, now a museum on the Galve Lake.

#### REGISTRATION AND ENTRY FEE

Applications are submitted via the electronic application system <a href="www.e-row.lt">www.e-row.lt</a>. If you have any questions about submitting the entry, please contact <a href="mailto:entry@e-row.lt">entry@e-row.lt</a>. Please check in the application system that you have entered all the details of your

athletes and that the information is correct.

In the online application system, there are two forms of registration. One for Friday - Saturday races and a separate registration for Sunday event.

The early online entry fee is applied until the 21st of June, 17:00. Late entry fees apply from 17:00 on June 21st until 17:00 on June 25th. New entries submitted after 25th June will not be accepted. After the application deadline, via the online application system, crew cancellations and changes must be done by the **27<sup>th</sup> of June at 17:00** by submitting a completed "Crew change" form to entry@lif.lt.

Entry fee shall not be refunded upon crew withdrawal except cases when doctor's certificate stating that the athlete has fallen ill after the entry was submitted. The entry fee already paid will not be credited towards the payment of new crews after the entry deadline.

If team manager does not withdraw the crew by 17:00 on 27th June, the team will be fined 20 EUR (per crew). If the team manager does not withdraw the crew on time, and the crew does not arrive at the start, the team shall be fined 50 euros (per crew).

Please note that the entry fee is applied separately for each set of medals for the Friday-Saturday and Sunday events.

The entry fee is payable to the Lithuanian Rowing Federation via the electronic entry system. If the entry fee cannot be paid via entry system, a bank transfer can be made manually using the following IBAN (international bank account details):



#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

On the 30th of June (Sunday), the Trakai Triathlon competition will also take place in the town. During the course of the competition vehicle traffic will be restricted on Karaimų street. Entry and exit to / from the Trakai sports base to Karaimų street will be permitted according to the following schedule:

The Karaimų street entry / exit to the Trakai sports base will be **OPEN**:

until 7:30 AM from 10:20 AM to 11:40 AM from 1:30 PM to 1:50 PM from 3:30 PM

Vehicle Parking

Friday - Saturday (June 28 - 29)

Parking on the territory of the Trakai sports base will be reserved exclusively for the participants of the event and competition personnel.



# ADDITIONAL

#### Sunday (June 30)

Entry / exit of vehicles to Karaimų g. 73 will be restricted according to the schedule provided above. If possible, we recommend parking all vehicles in the parking lot located on Karaimų g. 99 and continuing to the rowing base on foot.



**Boat - trailer parking** 

Due to the restricted vehicle access to Karaimų g. 73 on June 30, this year boat - trailer parking will be permitted on the territory of the rowing base. The location is marked on the map.



We kindly ask to follow recommendations, as this will allow you to avoid any trouble leaving Karaimy g. 73 after the competition on the 30th of June (Sunday).
