CALL FOR ENTRIES FOR THE BALTIC BEACH SPRINT ROWING CHAMPIONSHIP

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

We would like to inform you that the Baltic Beach Sprint Championship will take place on August 17 – 18.

II. LOCATION AND PROGRAMME OF THE EVENT

The championship will be held in Klaipeda, at the II Melnrage Beach (Antrosios Melnragės st. 12). The competition schedule may change depending on the number of participants and the weather conditions on the competition day. All changes related to the competition schedule will be sent to the team managers by email. Team managers must inform their athletes about the changes.

Athletes must be available to compete on both event days. In the case of unfavorable weather conditions, the competition will be postponed to the second competition day (August 18). If the weather conditions are favorable and there is a large number of participants, the competition will be held over two days (August 17-18). The preliminary competition schedule is attached to the invitation. The progression system used in the competition will be adapted based on the number of registered crews.

III. AGE GROUPS AND BOAT CLASSES

The championship will be held in the senior and U19 age groups. Participants must have undergone a health check and adhere to doctors' recommendations regarding physical exertion, and they must hold an athlete's license. Athletes with Russian or Belarusian citizenship are prohibited from participating in the competition.

IV. RACE COURSE

The championship will be contested using coastal rowing boats as defined by World Rowing competition rules. The equipment will be provided by the Lithuanian Rowing Federation.

The race course consists of: (1) a beach segment, (2) a water segment, and (3) a beach segment.

First part of the course: running from the start/finish line on the beach to the water, covering 30 meters.

Second part of the course: rowing around three buoys in the water. The first buoy is 85 meters from the shore, there is a distance of 85 meters between the first and second buoys, and the third buoy is an additional 80 meters away.

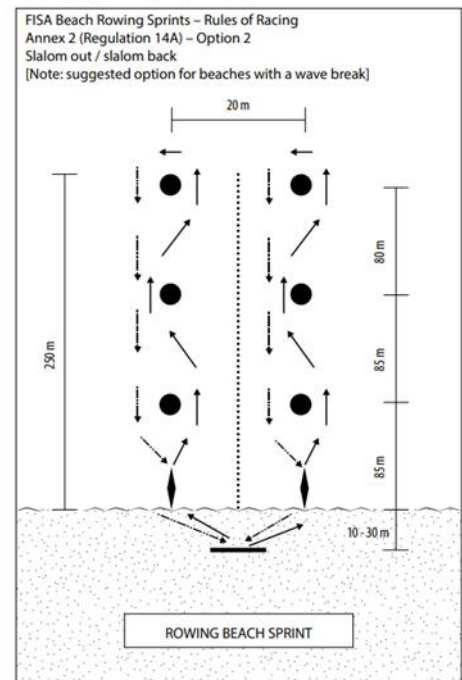
Third part of the course: Upon returning to the shore, running 30 meters on the beach back to the start/finish line.

V. REGISTRATION

Applications must be submitted via the electronic application system at www.e-row.lt. For any questions regarding the submission process, please contact entry@lif.lt via email. Please ensure that all athlete information is accurately entered and verified within the application system. No entry fee will be charged for this championship.

Applications via the electronic system must be submitted by 17:00 on Wednesday, August 14. Applications submitted after this deadline will not be accepted. Crew changes and withdrawals

can be made until 12:00 on Friday, August 16, by submitting a completed "Crew Change" form via email to entry@lif.lt.

If a team manager fails to withdraw a crew by 12:00 on August 16, a fine of 20 euros per crew will be imposed. If the team manager fails to withdraw a crew on time and the crew does not appear at the start, a fine of 50 euros per crew will be imposed.

VI. AWARDS

Winners of the championship will be awarded medals from the Lithuanian Rowing Federation and prizes established by sponsors. The awards will be presented 30 minutes after the last race.
